After a short holiday break, our school is full of life again! Since January 2nd, 2025, students have been returning, excited to reconnect with friends, teachers, and their learning journey. Seeing their smiling faces and eagerness to learn reminds us why we do what we do!

We're incredibly grateful for how much our school has grown over the years, and it's all thanks to the love and support from people like you. As we start this new year, we're excited to share some updates:

This year, at Umutara Deaf School we have a total of 334 students across different levels:

- → Nursery: 80 Students
- → Primary: 99 Students
- → Vocational Courses: 155 Students

Kayonza Deaf Blind Centre:

- → Deaf Blind: 8 Students
- → Deaf with low vision: 15 Students





A new year means new opportunities, and at Friends of Handicap in Rwanda (FHR), we have many exciting projects and programs ahead!
